It's improving the quality of residents' lives and enabling them to be more independent.</p> <p>Individual Placement Support (IPS) has a good evidence base showing that it is very effective for people with severe and enduring mental health problems and our IPS Works programme will be intending to allow people with common mental health conditions to access this tailored support.
